

3 Things to Look for Before Hiring a Painting Contractor

Use this checklist to compare painting contractors and choose a company that is qualified, transparent, and a good fit for your project.

1. Confirm the Company Is Legitimate

- ☐ Verify that the contractor is fully insured.
- ☐ Confirm that the company is properly bonded where applicable.
- ☐ Ask for references from previous customers.
- ☐ Review the company's Google ratings and recent customer feedback.
- ☐ Make sure the business can clearly explain its credentials and experience.

A legitimate painting contractor should be comfortable providing documentation, references, and proof of an established reputation.

2. Review the Quote Carefully

- ☐ Make sure the quote is detailed and in writing.
- ☐ Confirm that labor is clearly included.
- ☐ Check that materials are listed.
- ☐ Ask which paint products and quality levels will be used.
- ☐ Verify that surface preparation and repairs are included.
- ☐ Confirm that the quote reflects the specific needs of your project.
- ☐ Ask questions about anything that seems vague or incomplete.

Every painting project is different. A detailed quote helps prevent misunderstandings and makes it easier to compare contractors fairly.

3. Trust Your Overall Impression

- ☐ Choose a company that communicates clearly.
- ☐ Consider whether you feel comfortable with the contractor.
- ☐ Pay attention to professionalism, responsiveness, and attitude.
- ☐ Make sure the price feels fair for the scope of work.
- ☐ Research the company before making a final decision.
- ☐ Do not choose based on price alone.

If you trust the company, feel comfortable with the people involved, and believe the quote is fair, you are likely making a strong decision.
